

Script for stakeholders' assessment workshop

1. Welcome and introduction (15 minutes)

Introduce the challenge of WEF_e nexus in the focal area.

Explain the purpose of the workshop and provide an overview of the agenda and the exercises.

2. Presentation of the CLD, intervention(s), REWEFe and Ecosystem Services assessment (15 minutes)

This presentation should be organised in the follow steps:

1. CLD
2. Interventions identified in the third phase (through co-creation, by local experts, or by analysts). When presenting interventions, it is crucial to emphasize that these are not the only solution.
3. REWEFe scenarios
4. Ecosystem Services assessment from the Participatory System Mapping workshop

3. Validation of the Causal Loop Diagram (CLD) post-produced and analyse interventions in the CLD (90 minutes)

This exercise presents a comprehensive diagnosis of the region's challenges, serving as a foundation for discussion and collaborative exploration of the issues, the performance assessment results, and the relationships between the interventions and the CLD variables will be established.

Divide participants into groups of 4-6 people.

Provide a flipchart, Post-it and pens to each group so that they can freely organize their ideas and revise the CLD.

4. Assessing barriers and facilitators (around 40 minutes)

Participants will analyse barriers and facilitating factors related to the interventions that have been selected.

5. Impact Assessment on WEF components (around 40 minutes)

The goal is to gather insights from local stakeholders regarding the perceived positive or negative impacts (benefits or threats) that the selected interventions may have on the WEF nexus and associated local ecosystems.

6. Closing of the workshop

After the meeting, a report can be prepared that summarizes the results.
