

# Workshop set-up and logistics

**Purpose of the session:** Identify and discuss barriers and facilitating factors for adopting and operating 3–4 interventions to address WEF nexus problems in the focal area.

**Time:** approx. 60 minutes total (see below)

## **Roles and People Needed:**

- Facilitator(s): Guide plenary tasks and support group rapporteurs.
- Recorder: Take notes on questions and discussions by stakeholders
- Group Rapporteurs: Nominated participants to lead each subgroup.
- Group Participants: Invited stakeholders to engage in group activities.

## **Steps:**

- Plenary: Facilitator presents interventions, and outlines the session's purpose (10 minutes)
- Group Formation: Create 3 subgroups (approx. 10 participants each), with each subgroup nominating a rapporteur. Groups should ideally focus on different interventions. Ideally, groups are composed of diverse stakeholders and each WEF nexus sector is represented (5 minutes)
- Group work: Groups, guided by moderators familiar with the interventions, discuss barriers and facilitators for their assigned interventions (30 minutes)
- Plenary: Discussions and findings are reported to the plenary and discussed with all stakeholders (15 minutes)
